Clinical trial for canine intranasal adenocarcinoma

We are enrolling patients in a randomized, placebo-controlled clinical trial to evaluate a novel investigational product in dogs with intranasal adenocarcinoma.



Study Specifics:

Dogs will receive the novel investigational product or placebo every day, along with radiation therapy, for 5 consecutive days. Owners will be required to bring their dog to the study site for regularly scheduled appointments over a 4-month time period. Owners will also be required to document study associated observations as appropriate.

Inclusion Criteria:

- Must weigh at least 5kg (11lbs)
- Histologically diagnosed with stage 3 intranasal adenocarcinoma
- Dog is expected to tolerate multiple anesthesia events
- No known clinically significant cardiovascular arrhythmias

Exclusion Criteria:

- Dogs with metastatic cancer at screening
- The tumor invades a facial skin surface
- A history of receiving radiotherapy
